We visited many beautiful places in Spain, we did different activities, it was very fascinating.

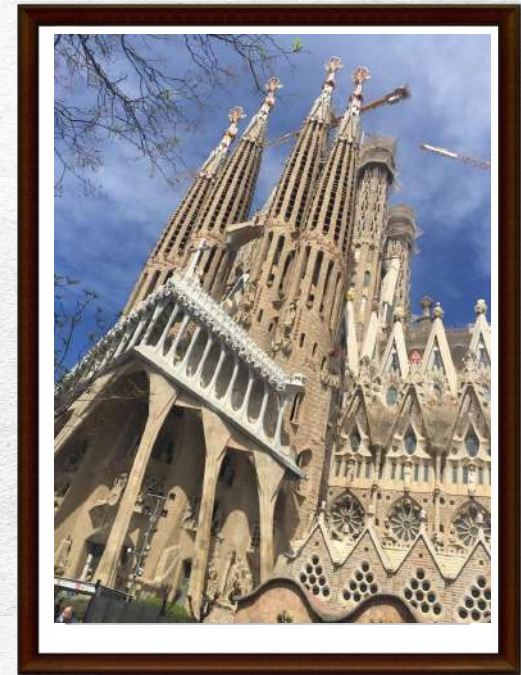
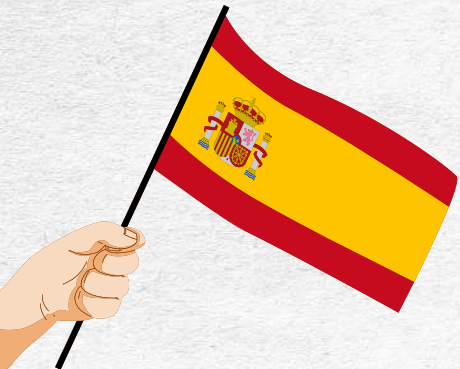

I like the river and the boat tour.

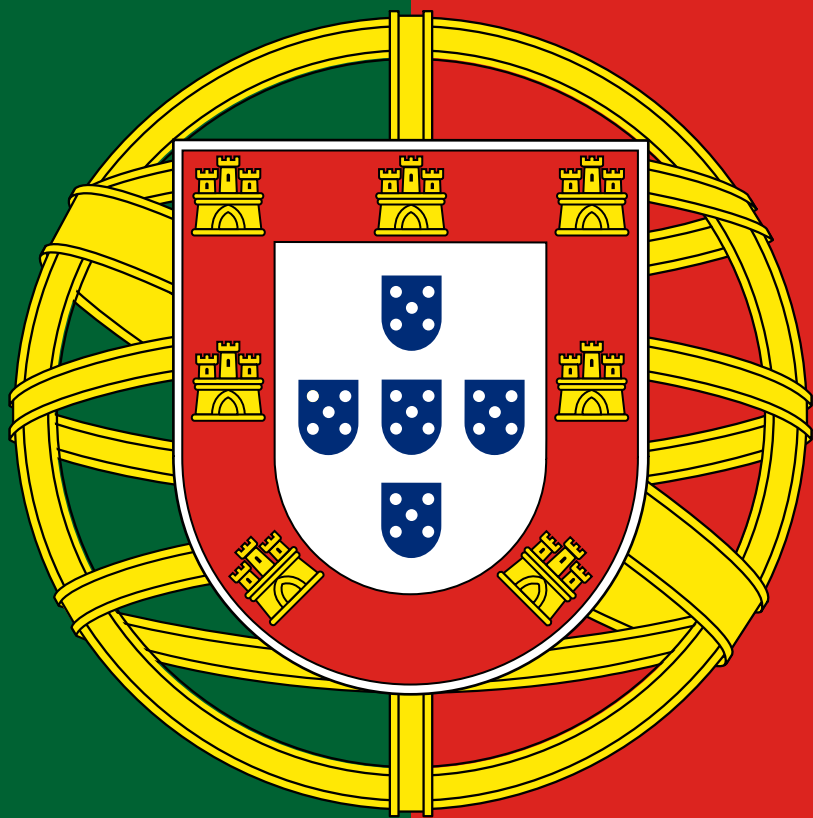


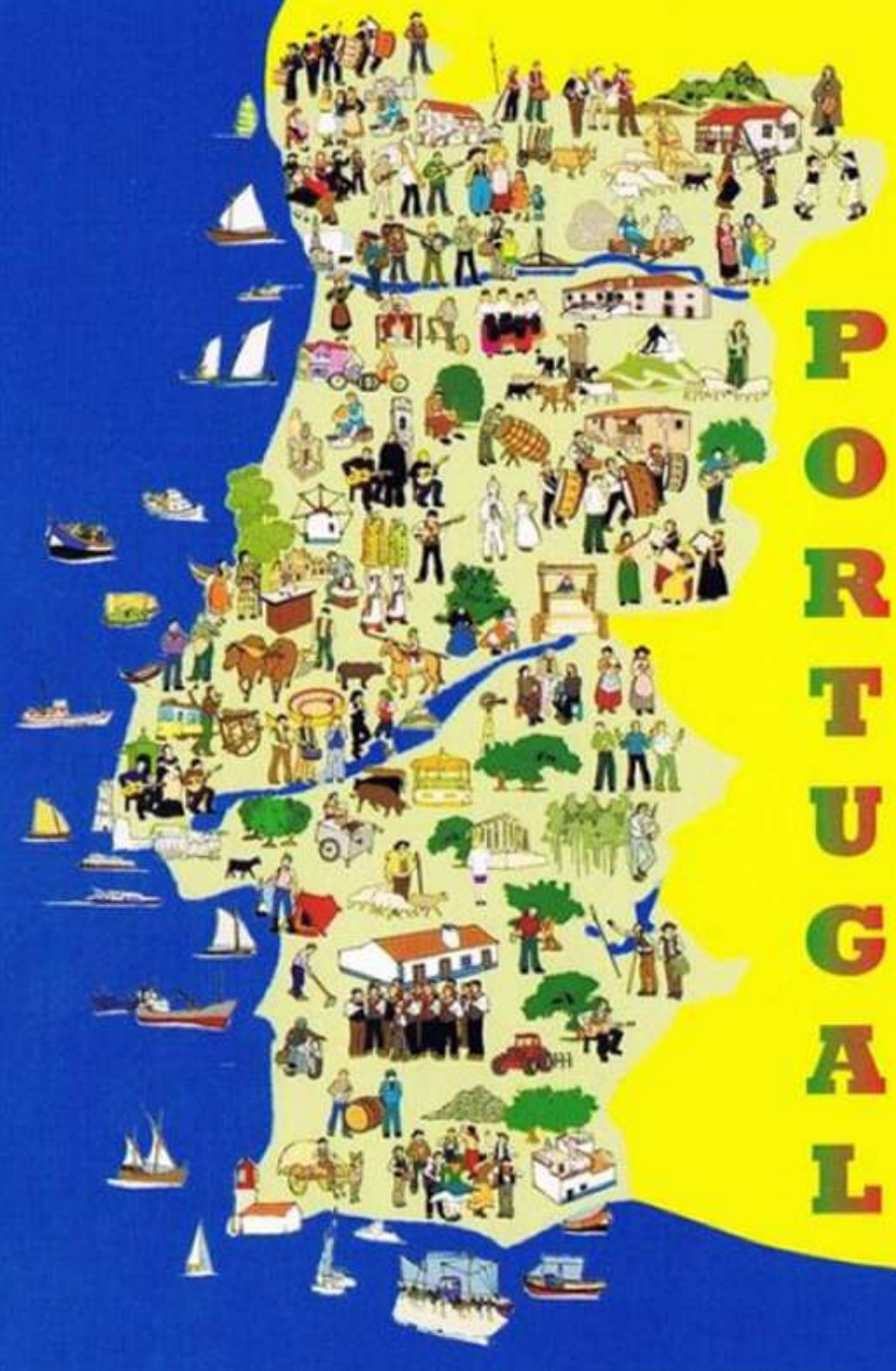
